The summer volume of "Seiju" featured the educational foundation Sōji Gakuen(Tsurumi University, the same Junior College, Tsurumi Women's Junior High School and the same High School), which was founded by Sōjiji-Temple in the 13th of Taishō to revive the spirit of the founder of Sojiji-Temple, the Rev.Keizan, "petition for women's attaining Buddhahood. The name of the school at that time was "Kouka Women's School", though the University and The Junior College (except some parts) are now coeducational to go with the current. This is exactly Buddhists' way of living and also the real beautiful life if you have sure feeling of life in the multifarious world.
